GROUND RULES

- Please follow all posted Health and Safety rules. We will update these as we get closer to the event.
- Failure to follow rules posted on the day of the event is cause for ejection.
- Smoking of tobacco is allowed on the fairgrounds but is strictly prohibited in all tents and buildings.
- Please don't erect tents, large sun umbrellas or other items that block the view of those behind you. A special area will be designated for tents and sun shades at the rear of the audience area. This area will be expanded this year to enhance social distancing.
- We do allow people to stand directly in front of the stage, so if you would like to enjoy the music from your lawn chair you may want to consider moving back closer to the sound mix area if you don't want someone standing in front of you.
- No pets are allowed on the grounds with the exception of assistance dogs.
- No videotaping or recording of artists' performances per our contracts with them.
- No coolers or glass of any kind are allowed into the festival grounds.
- No food or beverages allowed through festival gates except one unopened liter bottle of water.
- You will be asked to leave if you have brought in your own alcoholic beverages.
- No unauthorized vending, soliciting, petitioning, etc.
- We are not responsible for personal items left on the grounds, however, found items may be taken to Security at the Chenango Blues Festival's Main Entrance.
- All ticket sales are final. No refunds.

29th annual Chenango Blues Fest ready to rock

CHENANGO COUNTY - This weekend the 29th annual Chenango Blues Fest kicks-off, scheduled for Friday, August 19 and Saturday, August 20 at the Chenango County Fairgrounds.

"It's a great year for us. Jimmie Vaughan is a big headliner for us, we have a really strong lineup. Looking forward to being back to normal and doing the Blues Festival, so I think that will be great," said Chenango Blues Association Event Organizer Eric Larsen. "It's the highlight of the summer for us and hopefully for a lot of people as well."

The weekend's festivities will actually begin on Thursday, August 18, with another installment of the NBT Bank Free Summer Concert Series. Opening the evening will be local group the Nate Gross

8 p.m. Mike Zito's Big Band will take the East Park stage.

Friday's show will be free to attend, with parking opening at 4:30 p.m. and the festival gates opening at 5 p.m. The Hi-Jivers will kick off the show at 5:30 p.m., followed by Angel Forrest at 7:15 p.m., and lastly Popa Chubby taking the stage at 9 p.m.

On Saturday, parking gates will open at 10 a.m., with the festival gates officially opening at 11 a.m. Throughout the day, nine high-calwill be rocking the fairgrounds on the infield stage and tent stage.

Taking the infield stage at 11:30 a.m. will be the Misty Blues Band, followed by Annika Chambers at 12:30 p.m., Altered Five Blues Band at 2:45 p.m., and Nick Moss and special guest Dennis Gruenling performing at 5 p.m. The final infield stage performance will begin at 7:30 p.m., featuring headliner Jimmie Vaughan.

Larsen said RV tickets, which are \$50 extra for basic sites and \$75 extra for enhanced sites. are still available as well. However, they're going fast.

"Tent camping will be no problem right up until that Friday, and tent camping they can pay at the door. RVs will most likely be sold out. We have a few more, they can buy them now, but we don't sell them at the door and if anybody wants them they should buy it ASAP, because there's only a few left," said Larsen.

This year's festival will also feature a new addition - a raffle contest for an electric guitar crafted by former Norwich resident Mike Aronson.

The Hi-Jivers pay tribute to the Rock N' Roll and Rhythm & Blues of the 50s and 60s through their raw, wild originals and passionate covers. Their greatest influences include Muddy Waters, Howlin' Wolf, Magic Sam, Wynonie Harris, Big Mama Thornton, Johnny Guitar Watson, Little Walter, Chuck Berry and Ike Turner. Since moving to Nashville in 2014 (Dawna and Austin from Syracuse, NY, and Hank from Seattle, WA) The Hi-Jivers have played extensively in Nashville and beyond, performing at festivals such as Viva Las Vegas Rockabilly Weekender, The Nashville Boogie Vintage Weekender, and NYS Blues Festival. The band appeared on the cover of Blue Suede News Magazine's Spring 2018 issue, were featured in Vintage Rock Magazine, and appeared on Acme Radio Live in November, 2018.

Angel Forrest

In 1988, Angel Forrest began a musical career which would span over three decades - and counting. Her tribute show to the legendary Janis Joplin brought Angel into the public eye. She's won several awards, including Lys Blues Album of the Year, Songwriter of the year and a nomination for Recording of the Year for her album "Mother Tongue Blues". The Montreal artist was named Female Vocalist of the Year 7 times by the Toronto Blues Society between 2013 and 2021. The 2018 Memphis International Blues Challenge Finalist sings in the whole country, blues and rock spectrum.





Popa Chubby

Popa Chubby, born Ted Horowitz, has been hard rocking the blues in his fierce and soulful way for more than 30 years. Over the course of a career that dates back to 1994, he has been a force of to be reckoned with on the guitar, and his tempestuous, soulful playing has never been more powerful. An imposing figure with a shaven head, tattooed arms, a goatee and a performance style he describes as "the Stooges meets Buddy Guy, Motörhead meets Muddy Waters, and Jimi Hendrix meets Robert Johnson," Popa Chubby is an endearing character who is one of the genre's most

popular figures.

Misty Blues Challenge finalist, Misty Blues, is led by lead

singer/band founder Gina Coleman. The band is based out of Berkshire County, Massachusetts playing original and traditional blues with hints of jazz, soul, funk and tent revival gospel since 1999. The band has recorded with Charles Neville, Justin Johnson, Big Llou Johnson and Joe Louis Walker. The band has also opened for contemporary blues artists like Tab Benoit, Roomful Of Blues, John Primer, Albert Cummings and Michael Powers. Misty Blues performs extensively throughout New England and has toured New York City, Harrisburg, Mishawaka, Knoxville, Birmingham, Montgomery, Muscle Shoals, Clarksdale, Memphis, New Orleans and Ontario Canada. The band recently earned the 2021 CFAB Music Realm Best Entertainer Award and has amassed several Independent Blues Award nominations. The band's original





Whether on stage or in private life, these two internationally renowned artists are a perfect match! Since meeting in 2018 at the International Blues Challenge in Memphis, Tennessee, renowned Québec bluesman Paul DesLauriers and great American soul and blues singer Annika Chambers have united their artistic destiny to the great joy of those

Annika Chambers, like so many powerful vocal artists, can trace her love of music back to early childhood.

It was during her tour of duty in the US Army that her career began. Her colonel, having

heard her singing, asked her to sing the Anthem for a ceremony. She was an immediate hit, and from that moment on, she sang at all the ceremonies and then on a support tour

Returning to Houston in 2011 brought the creation of her musical project. Bassist Larry

Fulcher (2012 inductee to the Blues Hall of Fame) and producer/musician Richard Cagle of Montrose Records recruited her for her debut album, "Making My Mark", which climbed blues charts across the US and Europe. She won the Blues Music Award in May 2019 as the Best soul and blues singer in the United States. She is now expanding her touring

Altered Five Blues Band

This hip Milwaukee quintet is known for its strong brew of tough, original blues and hard-hitting live shows. Blues Blast raves that barrel-chested front man Jeff Taylor possesses a "smooth, warm-toned voice as monumental and undeniable as Howlin' Wolf with the finish and flourish of B.B. King." Downbeat declares stealth guitarist Jeff Schroedl "reaches the high bar of mixed invention and fluidity." Fueled by a rhythm section laying down the deepest grooves this side of the MGs, the five blues blasters hit the ground running 20 years ago and show no sign of easing up.

EG Kight Trío Through the years Kight has developed her own unique

sound. Creative Loafing magazine noted that on her new record "Kight is in strong, smooth, controlled voice throughout the record, with dollops of Phoebe Snow, Bonnie Raitt, and even Patsy Cline injected with a dose of Southern charm, class, and a

Kight was the epitome of "Americana" before there was a genre. And in a world that seemingly needs to put a label on everything, it's clear that Kight's own "country flavored southern fried blues" straddles the line between Americana and Blues, and gives the listener a hefty dose of the best of both worlds.



Nick Moss Band featuring Dennís Gruenlíng

Blues guitar virtuoso Nick Moss and harmonica wizard Dennis Gruenling have been on a winning streak since they first joined forces in 2016. With relentless nonstop touring and the release of their Alligator 岁 Records debut, The High Cost Of Low Living, in 2018, The Nick Moss Band Featuring Dennis Gruenling has been playing for wildly enthusiastic fans and winning over critics and radio programmers worldwide. Debuting at #3 on the Billboard Blues Chart, the album topped many 2018 "Best Of" lists. UK tastemaker magazine Mojo said, "Guitarist and singer Nick Moss shows the world his fearsome guitar chops and his complete familiarity with the great tradition of Chicago blues music. Partnered with harmonica-player Dennis Gruenling, Moss creates a two-headed monster that takes the band thundering through crisp originals." Although Moss and Gruenling had known each other for 20 years and had jammed together often. On stage, the two communicate seemingly telepathically, as Moss lays down the deepest blues licks and Gruenling's harmonica wails and howls in perfect response, with Moss' top-notch band completing the ensemble with their energy and expertise.

Teresa James and the Reversion Transs, have long

reigned as one of Los Angeles' leading contemporary blues outfits, even though their uncommonly imaginative repertoire, much of it supplied by Terry Wilson, James' husband, producer, and bassist, is by no means strictly limited to the 12-bar form. Their 2019 CD Here in Babylon was nominated for a Grammy in the

Soon to have a full dozen albums under their collective belt spanning 23 exciting years, Teresa James & the Rhythm Tramps remain a staple of the Los Angelesarea blues scene in addition to an international touring artist, with a sound all their

own. Moving easily from Texas-style grease and blues into Memphis soul or New Orleans-flavored grooves and all points in between with fun and abandonment, as one critic said, "there are no clichés in this band."

Southern Avenue

Memphis-based, Grammy nominated, Southern Avenue inked their first record deal with legendary Stax Records in 2016. The first Memphis band signed to Stax in over 40 years, their self-titled debut was an immediate phenomenon, reaching #1 on iTunes' "Top Blues Albums" chart before being honored with the 2018 Blues Music Award for "Best Emerging Artist Album." 2019's Keep On proved an even greater success, debuting among the top 5 on Billboard's "Top Blues Albums" chart amidst worldwide critical acclaim, ultimately earning Southern Avenue their first Grammy Award nomination, for "Best Contemporary Blues Album/"

In addition to the early success that the band has had with their recordings, they have also found a home on the road. The band has performed in 15 countries on three continents and averages over 150 shows in a typical year, making the group one of the most sought-after live performance experiences. Their high-energy shows have captivated audiences around the globe, making this eclectic group a







When it comes to the blues today, there are a handful of guiding lights to make sure the music stays true to its powerful source. The sound of pleasure and pain that first sparked musicians to create such a sound is a force that can never be underestimated. The mojo has to be there. For Jimmie Vaughan, he's dedicated his life to making sure the blues not only stays alive, but remains full of life and an inspiration to all who listen. It's a spirit he holds close to him, and for over 50 years of holding the blues close inside him, Vaughan isn't about to stop now.

"Playing what you feel has always been my main goal," Vaughan says. Considering the Texas guitarist and singer has had the kind of career that makes him a living legacy, those are no idle words. Jimmie Vaughan's new album, Baby, Please Come Home, is a rolling

and righteous celebration of everything the blues can be. The songs can go up, down, sideways and even off in their own distinctive direction, but one thing is certain, each and every one of them is packed with pure feeling and striking originality. That's because while the blues is almost as old as America itself, every time a musician lends their soul to living inside these songs, something new comes out.

All the activities of C.B.A. are governed by a volunteer board of directors consisting of thirteen community members drawn from Chenango County. There is no paid staff and no office expense so all contributions directly increase our ability to expand programming.

The major activities of the C.B.A. are a mid-August Blues Festival weekend held at the Chenango County Fairgrounds, 168 East Main St. in Norwich, NY and a Free Summer Concert Series held in East Park, Norwich in which we present different genres of music including Zydeco, Jazz, Bluegrass, Big-Band Swing orchestra, Americana, Country Rock and Reggae. These events collectively draw thousands of people from throughout the Northeast.

The Mike Zito Big Band is scheduled to play in East Park on Thursday with the Nate Gross Band opening for them. Considered by many to be the unofficial kick-off to the weekend. Many Blues fans come in early to make it a 3-day weekend. We always encourage people to check out the area (Museum District, YMCA and the Greenway, local restaurants and clubs) during the day on Friday before the Festival opens late Friday afternoon.

Mike Zito is an American guitarist, singer, record producer, and songwriter from St. Louis, Missouri and one of the most lauded artists in the contemporary blues arena today, and rightfully so. Zito has won BMAs in the categories of Blues Rock Artist as well as Blues Rock Album of the Year for Mike Zito and Friends - Rock 'n' Roll: A Tribute to Chuck Berry. His album, Resurrection won a 2022 Blues Music Award.

Thursday, August 25 Last Show of the Season — Trigger Hippy

Trigger Hippy's music harnesses their collective roots in Country, Delta blues, R&B, Gospel and Southern rock. "We hit it off right away" says Govrik "and we've been doing it virtually non stop since." There have been an evolving group of collaborators over the years before the current lineup of multi instrumentalist Ed Jurdi (Band of Heathens) and vocalist/sax player Amber Woodhouse emerged. It's the culmination of a long journey, and the new lineup demonstrates a new commitment to great music built on a solid foundation.
