Village of New Berlin reopens road ahead of schedule

NEW BERLIN – Village of New Berlin officials recently reopened West Street after over a month of construction and an early completion date for their new culvert.

According to Village of New Berlin Mayor Terry Potter, village officials voted to accept a \$173,000 bid last month as part of a culvert replacement project, and at that time the construction company handling the work estimated that the project would be completed around Thanksgiving.

“We finished ahead of schedule thanks to the engineer’s and the contractor’s efficiency,” said Potter. “That allowed us to get the street back open before the Thanksgiving holi-

day, a time where a lot of families are traveling through the area, and we want to ensure that traversing the village is as convenient as possible.”

“We appreciate the public’s patience while we did the necessary repairs, and we were happy to be able to get

this done without raising village taxes.”

He said during the village’s October meeting board members awarded the bid to Bothar Construction for the amount of \$173,000 which was covered using the village’s reserve money.

He added that the



situation needed to be addressed immediately, and the village quickly worked to find a solution.

“Back in the spring, one of the edges of a culvert under West Street collapsed,” said Potter. “We called in engineers and contracts to take a look at it, and

based on their assessments it needed immediate attention.”

“We’re pleased with the completion of the project, and we’ll continue to monitor the culvert in the future.”

He said the culvert’s slabs were installed on Tuesday, November 19, and the paving took

place on November 21.

“The street was reopened on the 21st, and I can’t thank PC Engineering and Design, Bothar Construction, the village clerk, treasurer, and board enough for their hard work throughout the project,” said Potter.

He said prior to reopening the road, the village was detouring traffic that came from County Route 320, also known as Kings Settlement Road.

He added that the village reached out to local businesses at the time of the road closure to let them know that some of their larger trucks would have to travel from Route 23 to Route 8, and that he appreciated their patience as the village worked to finish the project.

Morris man facing three months in jail after 2018 stabbing

NORWICH – A Morris man was sentenced to serve three more months in jail in Chenango County Court on Monday after stabbing a co-worker in May of last year.

Philip C. Cuda, 46, of Morris was charged with assault in the first degree, a class B felony, following an altercation that left a victim hospitalized with stab wounds.

As part of his plea deal, Cuda admitted that on May 28, 2018, in the Town of Norwich, he caused serious physical injuries to a victim by stabbing the victim in the stomach and the back with a knife; resulting in the victim undergoing emergency surgery at UHS Wilson Medical Center.

In court on Monday,

Cuda apologized for stabbing the victim, and he was told by officials that he was lucky the victim requested a light sentence.

“I’m sorry for what happened,” said Cuda. “He was a friend of mine – I loved that man.”

Shortly after, Cuda was sentenced to six months in jail followed by five years of post-release supervision.

Chenango County District Attorney Michael Ferrarese said the sentence could have been considerably longer, if not for the victim’s desire to keep Cuda out of prison.

“This is a terrible and tragic situation,” said Ferrarese. “You should be grateful that [the victim] asked for this sentence.”

Chenango County Court Judge Frank Revoir Jr., agreed with Ferrarese and said,

“Without the victim’s input this was clearly going to be a state prison sentence.”

Revoir said if Cuda does well in jail, he will have three months to serve until he is released. He added that even though Cuda has tested positive for illegal drugs between the time of the incident and now, he was going to be given an opportunity to get clean.

“We want you to get these issues taken care of,” said Revoir. “If you get out and test positive for any illegal substances, then I’m no longer bound by the plea deal, and you could go to prison.”

Revoir said no order of protection or restitution was requested by the victim.

According to Former Chenango County District Attorney Joseph McBride around the

time of Cuda’s arrest, the initial allegation was that Cuda stabbed someone and caused them serious physical injury. He added that allegedly the victim could have died or had significant impairment of his health because of the stabbing.

“And so it was not just a flesh wound, for lack of a better term; the allegation is that the wound that the victim received could have, in

fact, killed him,” said McBride.

McBride said the victim was stabbed in his abdomen.

A release from the Chenango County Sheriff’s Office said the victim was transported to UHS Chenango Memorial Hospital before being transferred to UHS Wilson Medical Center. They stated the victim was later announced to be in stable condition.

NORWICH – The Chenango SPCA is over capacity and calling on the community for support.

The local shelter can hold between 100 to 125 animals comfortably. Currently they have 176 cats and 11 dogs in shelter and more cats with foster caretakers.

SPCA Executive Director Annette Clarke said that abandonment rates are high, and adoption rates are low.

“Last year at this time we had adopted out 444 animals, this year we’re only at 388,” explained Clarke.

Clarke recalled a recent abandonment, “There was a tote of kittens left in our back parking lot, if no one had worked that day or saw that tote, I don’t know that those kittens would have made it.”

Currently adoption fees are being waived until the end of November, making it easier than ever to adopt.

The SPCA also has an immediate need for foster pet owners. The volunteers care for the animals while they await adoption, taking

material stress off the shelter. The volunteers typically make a 2 to 4 week commitment to foster cats in their homes.

To inquire about becoming a foster pet owner, contact the Chenango SPCA by calling 607-334-9724 ext. 3.

In addition to foster needs, the SPCA relies on community donations to cover about a third of costs.

The shelter spends about \$1,000 a day to run. A large portion of community donations are made through the SPCA’s monthly donors, called the Loyal Friends Monthly Donor Program.

“There’s no donation too small, everything helps,” said Clarke. Another large portion of community donations come from local fundraising efforts.

From 1 p.m. to 4 p.m., on Nov. 24, the Blarney Stone Pub will be hosting the 11th annual Woof-stock.

The event will have live music from 4 different local artists and munchies provided by the SPCA board. There will be sweatshirts and long sleeve shirts commemorating the event

for sale. Cost of admission is a good will donation, and 100 percent of proceeds go directly to the local SPCA.

If you’d like to support the shelter, while getting a special treat for your pooch, then Gilligans in Sherburne has you covered.

From now until December 7, every pint Gilligans sells of the limited edition Peanut Butter Canine Crunch Ice Cream, they will donate \$3 to the Chenango SPCA.

Andy Lagoe, co-owner of Gilligans, came to the Chenango SPCA with the idea after having a successful similar fundraiser with the Sherburne School. After collaborating with Clarke, a recipe was made for vanilla ice cream with a peanut butter swirl and milk bone dog biscuits. If you don’t have a dog, there will be flavors more tailored to humans available to order as well.

Orders can be placed online or by submitting an order form to the Chenango SPCA. Order will be available for pick up December 17 from 12 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Chenango SPCA parking lot.

Chenango United Way strives to meet local need

NORWICH – The Chenango United Way increased the annual capital campaign goal by \$6,000 in hopes of better meeting community needs.

In September, the United Way announced it would be seeking \$425,000 in donations for 2019, which is a \$6000 more than 2018 when the group aimed to raised \$419,000.

“There’s so much need in the community, and were trying to meet that need,” said United Way Executive Director Elizabeth Monaco. “Currently we’ve raised \$81,623, but most of our larger donations come in towards the end of the year.”

The Chenango United Way funds 27 local programs. The

funded programs fall under four categories education, financial stability, health, and other impact efforts. According to Monaco the programs being funded are the ones that will make the most impact. “We’re funding programs that bring people together to solve a community issue.”

Just like the many other programs the United Way funds, The Chenango Dental Task Force has had a significant impact on the community. According to the United Way facts guide, last year 613 kids participated in the in-school tooth brushing program, where kids brush their teeth once a day while in school. “Kids are 30 percent less likely to have cavities by brushing their teeth in school,” said Monaco. The task force

also visited norwich schools twice last year and handed out 38,000 tooth brush kits to students, she said.

The United Way is still \$343,377 short of the overall goal.

Although they receive corporate donations, Monaco noted 7 out of 10 donations for the Chenango United Way come from individual payroll deductions. According to the United Way’s facts guide, just \$1 a week provides two children with 12 free books a year; \$5 a week could provide 36 pounds of food for a local food pantry; \$10 a week would provide three children with after-school care.

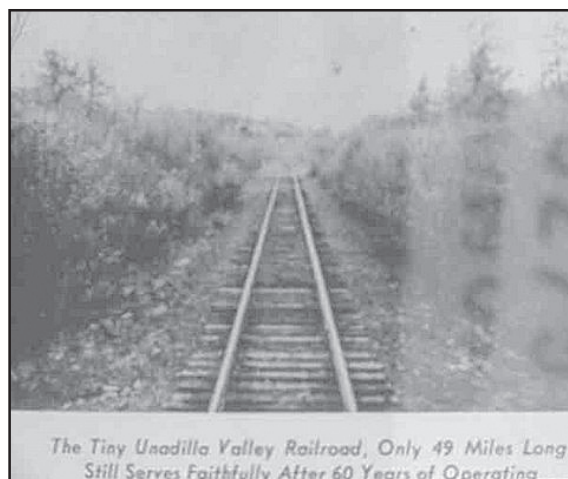

The End of the Line

The Unadilla Valley Railroad, or any of its other names, was important to the residents of the valley for nearly 100 years. It was more than a cute little short line train that puffed its way along the valley. It was not the "little engine that could." Initially a collection of steam engines, later dominated by the orange/white/ and black diesel locomotives, it was an iconic presence. Its engineers, firemen, and conductors (Bruce Harshberger, Howard Cadwell, Joe Graham, and John Hoxie) were local celebrities and worshipped by small farm boys and girls.

The UVRR was not a toy. Quite a bit of early freight on the UV was agricultural, including milk and dairy products, and hops. Hops were a large part of Otsego County history until the turn of the 20th century, when the hops trade was lost to other markets. But the Unadilla Valley also had some manufacturing. The largest manufacturing client on the road were the Babcock Shops in Leonardsville, a foundry operation manufacturing cast iron stoves. Babcock received shipments of iron ore and coal, and in turn shipped out stoves and furnaces.

The end of the line to the north was Bridgewater. The Bridgewater railroad station was located on the Unadilla Valley Railroad Company tracks which tied the Delaware, Lackawanna and Western RR to the Ontario and Western in the south. To raise money for the rail-

road, communities along the route were asked to raise money through the issuance of town bonds. Work began at Bridgewater in 1889 but because of financial difficulties work was stopped and not begun again until 1892. Gradually the line was extended south into Leno. The relationship of the UVRR with the DL&W to the north was very close. This was the shortest way to Utica and the markets there, and cooperation was high. Indeed, the Bridgewater Station, where the UVRR was financed jointly between the two roads, with the DL&W paying for 2/3 the cost of the station (and the station master's salary) and the UVRR paying 1/3. The same could not be said for relations with the NYO&W to the south at New Berlin, and bad blood would hamper relations between the two for many years to come. The two railroads, met in New Berlin but did not, would not, and never did share a depot. One depot, now restored by the local UV Railway Society was located less than 1000 feet from the other depot located at the bottom of Academy Street.

The demise of the UVRR was inevitable. The NYO&W decided to tear up its tracks south of Mt. Upton. The Mount Upton milk plant closed in 1956. The Kraft plant in South Edmeston changed its heating system from coal to oil, which was easily transportable by truck. Cattle businesses also committed to trucks. The Babcock manufacturing plant in Leonardsville was sold and closed its shop.

Eventually, after changes in ownership and bankruptcies caused by political disputes, the UVRR was unable to continue operations. In 1960,

the Salzburg Company filed a petition to discontinue operations. Several options to keep the railroad alive were discussed, but in the end, the petition was approved.

In September 1960 a clean-up train ran north to Bridgewater, taking the last of the UV rolling stock; the rails were pulled up soon thereafter, marking the end of the road. It was a sad day when the last engine and railroad cars headed north for the scrap heap.

Curiously many of the UVRR depots continue to exist and have been "re-purposed" as the historic preservationists say. A delightful historic photograph of the Bridgewater Depot accompanies this column. The photograph dates from the late 1800's. The depots remaining are located up and down the UVRR or nearby tracks and are located in Bridgewater, Leonaardsville, West Edmeston, Edmeston, South Edmeston, New Berlin, South New Berlin and the NYO&W's depot at Mount Upton, etc. A day trip auto tour exploring them is an adventure through local history.

Some of the original rights of ways are open to the public for walking, biking, and hiking. A recent addition to the local hiking/trail system is located in Pittsfield. The William Quinn Beardslee Memorial Conservation Trail is open to the public after obtaining permission by a telephone call (Shawn Patrick-607-226-1211) to the caretaker. It begins at the Memorial Gazebo behind the Town of Pittsfield buildings on NYS Route 80 approximately one mile east of New Berlin and extends approximately 2500 feet through the impressive Wharton Creek wetlands..

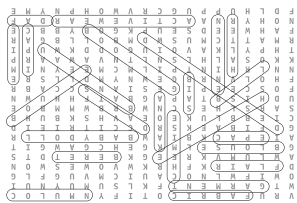

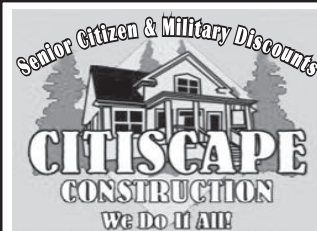

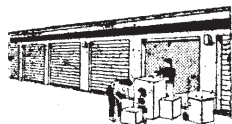

Seward calls for halt of new bail laws

State Senator James L. Seward (R/C/I – Oneonta) today voiced his strong support for several measures to protect crime victims and enhance public safety. Senator Seward is co-sponsoring bills that will address concerns voiced by law enforcement, district attorneys, local elected leaders, and the general public regarding legislation scheduled to take effect at the start of 2020.

“I have always believed that protecting the public is one of the most important responsibilities of government, and when a crime has been committed the victim, not the criminal, should be our first priority,” said Senator Seward. “I am standing up for law-abiding citizens and calling for changes to several recently approved laws that will put citizens at risk.”

Senator Seward is co-sponsoring:

S.6839 – giving judges discretion to set bail in domestic violence cases;

S.6840 – allowing judges to consider whether a defendant poses a danger to the

community when determining bail;

S.6849 – repealing criminal justice reforms enacted in the 2019-20 state budget including bail and discovery changes;

S.6853 – placing a one-year moratorium on criminal justice reforms to hold statewide hearings on the measures.

“I voted against the so-called criminal justice reform measures because they put criminals first. While I spoke with district attorneys and law enforcement officials in my senate district before these new laws were approved, it seems others in Albany failed to reach out to the experts. If they had, they would have known about the dangerous unintended consequences associated with these laws that will put the safety of crime victims at risk, particularly domestic violence victims,” said Seward.

The “reform” measures enacted this year, eliminate cash bail and pre-trial detention for most offenses and will result in the mandatory release of 90% of perpetrators arrested, regardless of criminal history.

“Under the new laws set to take effect on

January 1, 2020 perpetrators arrested for manslaughter, assault, criminal possession of a gun, and a number of drug sale offenses will all be released without bail. These suspects will be back on the streets immediately even if they have a criminal past,” added Seward.

When the new bail reform measures take effect on January 1, 2020, judges will only have the power to set bail if they determine that a defendant is a flight risk. A defendant’s criminal history, or the fact that they may pose a clear physical threat to another person, cannot be considered, creating a system in which a violent offender is likely sent back into the community, unsupervised and able to come into contact with their victim, the victim’s loved ones, and others.

“Along with the serious public safety concerns posed by the lack of bail, new discovery laws will force several unfunded mandates on our county district attorney offices and police departments. Small rural departments that are already understaffed and underfunded will be forced to hire personnel and purchase new

computer systems to comply with new deadlines and requirements. In the end, taxpayers will be footing the bill to help with the defense of suspected criminals,” said Seward.

The District Attorneys Association of the State of New York it will cost \$100 million for extra staff and other resources for offices outside of New York City to comply with the new discovery laws.

“Earlier this year, I joined with my Senate Republican colleagues to call for passage of a package of bills to reform the parole system to keep violent criminals behind bars and ease the parole process for suffering victims, families and the public. Those bills were not considered by the Democrat Majority. Instead, they pushed through measures that will put criminals first and endanger the public. These new bills I am co-sponsoring would right a serious wrong and tilt the scales of justice back toward law-abiding citizens,” Seward concluded.

As of January 1, 2020, a defendant must be released from custody without bail for the following crimes:

- Manslaughter in the second degree

- Aggravated vehicular homicide
- Criminally negligent homicide
- Assault in the third degree
- Aggravated vehicular assault
- Making a terroristic threat
- Criminal possession of a gun on school grounds/criminal possession of a firearm
- Criminal sale of a firearm to a minor
- Arson in the third and fourth degree
- Money laundering in support of terrorism in the third and fourth degree
- Promoting or possessing an obscene sexual performance by a child
- Aggravated cruelty to animals, overdriving, torturing and injuring animals, animal fighting
- Unlawful imprisonment in the first degree
- Coercion in the first degree
- Grand larceny in the first degree
- Criminal possession of a controlled substance in the first and second degree
- Criminal sale of a controlled substance in the first and second degree, or near/on school grounds
- Specified felony drug

- offenses involving the use of children, including the use of a child to commit a controlled substance offense and criminal sale of a controlled substance to a child
- Criminal solicitation in the first degree and criminal facilitation in the first degree
- Patronizing a person for prostitution in a school zone
- Failure to register as a sex offender
- Obstructing governmental administration in the first and second degree, or by means of a self-defense spray device
- Bribery and bribe receiving in the first degree, bribe giving for public office
- Promoting prison contraband in the first and second degree
- Resisting arrest
- Hindering prosecution
- Tampering with a juror and tampering with physical evidence
- Aggravated harassment in the first degree
- Directing a laser at an aircraft in the first degree
- Criminal possession of a weapon in the fourth degree
- Enterprise corruption and money laundering in the first degree

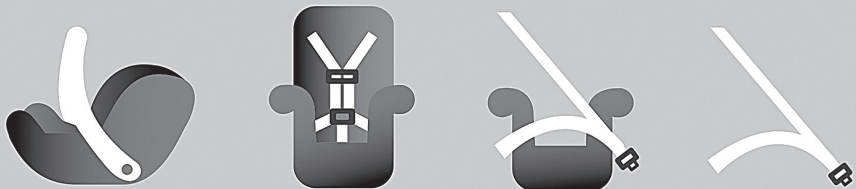

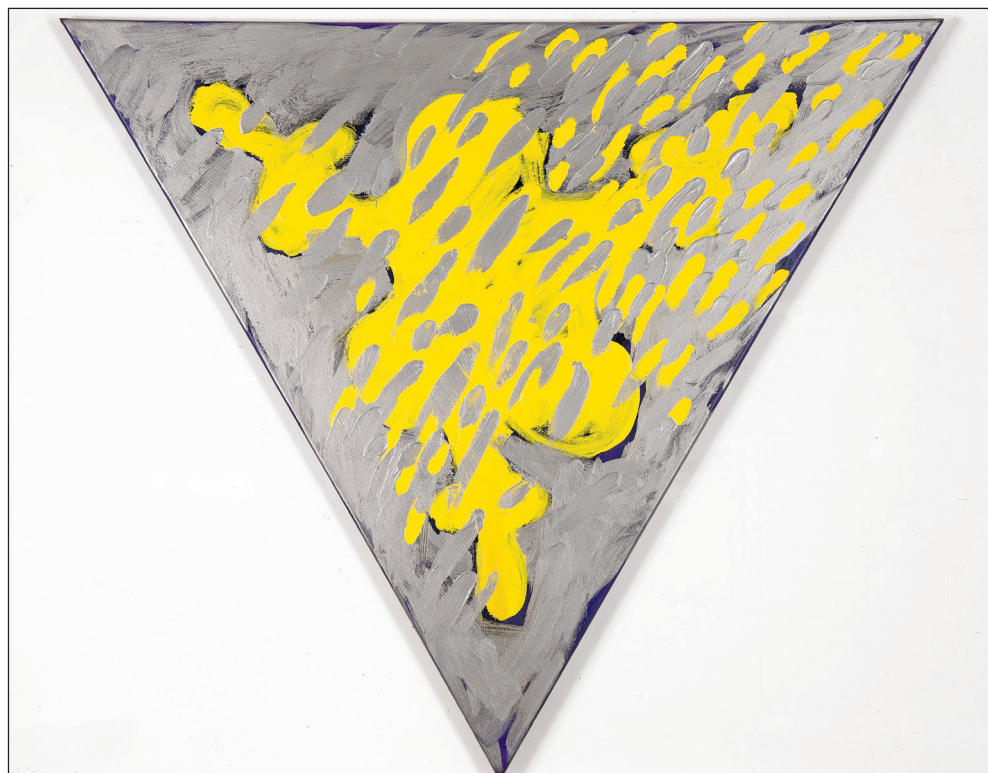

Utica Museum of Art to Present Huot Retrospective



UTICA — Munson-Williams-Proctor Arts Institute Museum of Art proudly presents “Robert Huot Paintings,” a retrospective look at an artist’s core motivation for 60 years, creating conceptually interesting and skillfully crafted paintings October 13, 2019 through January 19, 2020

Robert Huot (born 1935) has been an artist and politically engaged citizen for much of his life. By his early 30s, he had established himself as an active player in the New York City art scene. He was a serious painter of large, minimalist canvases that were critically well received; he exhibited regularly at commercial galleries in New York and in Europe; he collaborated with his peers, including artist Robert Morris and choreographer Twyla Tharp, his first wife; and he was invited to participate in notable exhibitions at the Guggenheim Museum, the Museum of Modern Art, and the Whitney Museum of American Art. By art world standards, Robert Huot was a success.

By the end of the

tumultuous 1960s, Huot grew increasingly disenchanted with the art world, its commercialization, and its seeming obliviousness to volatile issues of the day, particularly the United States’ war with Vietnam. As a member of the Art Workers Coalition, he actively protested the war and other injustices, but Huot describes his art and life at this moment as a disappearing act: his paintings became conceptual and ephemeral, and he moved from New York to an upstate farm in rural Chenango County. Huot stopped painting traditional, rectangular canvases but he remained an creative force, making films; producing an impressive body of work known as the Diary Paintings; performing with his band, the Chameleons; and collaborating with artist Carol Kinne, his wife, on a variety of artistic and political projects; all the while commuting weekly to teach at Hunter College.

“Robert Huot Paintings” includes major, representative works from all eras of his career. His early

paintings, such as “Chriss,” 1964, demonstrate Huot’s ability to create a dynamic, active composition with a minimal palette and few forms. “Shear,” 1963, disrupts the expected single plane of a painting’s surface by shifting the vertical painted bands in relation to the actual line where the works’ two panels meet. By the middle of the 1960s, Huot was preoccupied with uniting his paintings with the wall. He experimented with several kinds of solutions, including using rounded stretcher bars in works such as “Silver Kiss,” 1968. In the same pursuit, Huot created a series of works made of translucent nylon stretched over silver-painted bars, saying, “The nylon took the painting’s clothes off and let the wall show through.” By 1969-70, Huot had abandoned object-making for filmmaking and conceptual art.

By his own admission, it was difficult for Huot to leave the creative practice of painting entirely. In 1971 he began a hybrid series called the Diary

Paintings, which are scrolls of unstretched canvas, many feet long, that document Huot’s farm-life experiences, reactions to politics, and include paintings and drawings. They are personal and are intentionally uncommercial.

In the 1990s, Huot entered another remarkably fruitful period of painting, working as prolifically as he had 30 years earlier. With the equilateral trian-

gle as his matrix, Huot painted expressively about themes that have engaged him his entire life: art history, contemporary politics, and, most critically, the nature of painting itself. In contrast to the minimalist approach from his youth, these are expressively painted, and are grouped in series that include “Icons,” “Homages,” “Post-Atomic,” and “Signs and Measures.”

Robert Huot’s story is one of living life on one’s own terms. This exhibition examines his significant body of work that he perceived to be at the heart of his métier, paintings, to introduce or reintroduce his oeuvre and broaden the collective understanding of post-World War II art in the United States.

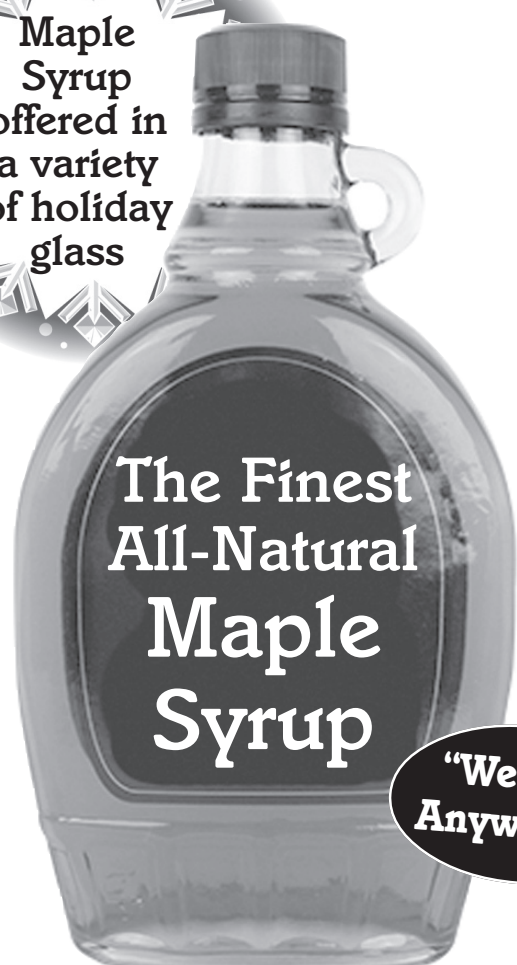

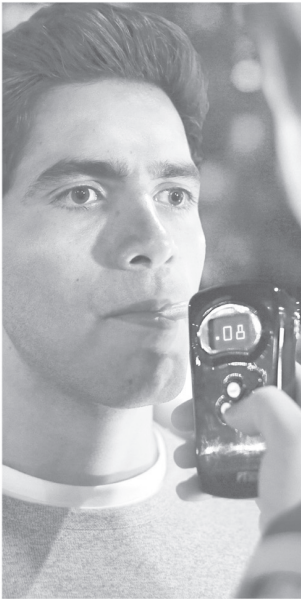

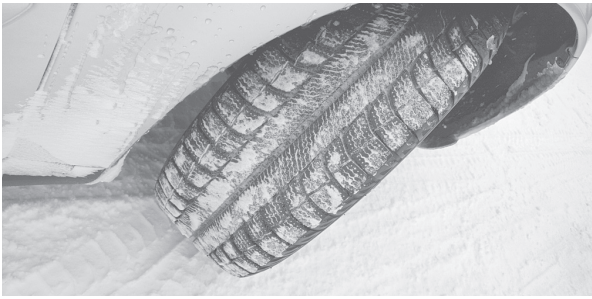
